All committees are advisory and subject to the authority and direction of the Board, which may allocate and reallocate responsibilities among the committees. Committee members and chairpersons are appointed by the President under By-Law 10. All committees are important and help to carry out our mission, operations, and programming. There is a signup sheet in the office, or you may email your interests to the President.

Standing Committees

Audit	Reviews and evaluates the scope of the work to be performed by independent auditors.
Buildings & Grounds	Assists in the development and implementation of a maintenance program for our buildings, parks, and common lands and makes recommendations for a healthful, quiet, and safe environment.
By-Laws	Review Bylaws for clarifications, conformity with current practices and law and other suggestions for amendments from the Committee, or Board of Trustees.
Development	Assist in fundraising efforts and create opportunities for donors by coordinating development strategies. Recommends policies to the Board and assists the staff with research, communications, and other fundraising initiatives.
Education	Enhance the educational programs of the Association and help recruit outstanding teachers for course offerings. Assist the Education Director in administering the program.
Finance	Examines the financial condition of the Association; devises plans and to fund the programs and operations; makes recommendations with respect to proposed revenues and expenditures.
Investment Advisory	Define sound investment goals and practices. Provides guidance on investment opportunities, the spend policy to achieve long term goals and recommends a qualified investment professional.
Long Range Planning	Create, administer, and evaluate our strategic plan.
Membership	Assures Bay View requirements for membership are met by applicants and makes recommendation to the Board.
Operations	Determine safety guidelines and good use programs for Association streets, alleyways, and utilities.
Performing Arts	Ensure imaginative and entertaining programs.
Personnel	Develops and implements personnel policies and recommends programs for productive and satisfying working conditions. Completes the performance evaluation of the Executive Director and assists with dispute resolution.
Recreation	Works to enhance and support the athletic and recreational programs.
Worship	Develops programs to enhance the spiritual emphasis of the Association and aiding in the implementation of worship, guest speakers, and other religious programs.



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Adjunct & Special Committees

Architectural Review	Maintain the aesthetics and historic landmark status of the Association by reviewing applications for modification or additions on cottages.
Archives	Collect, organize, and preserve the meaningful heritage of the Association
Assessors	Determines the sums of money to be paid to the Association by each of the cottage owners.
Campus Club	Offers entertainment, learning, fellowship, and exercise to Club members.
Chapel	Document and provide service in Chapel events and preserve its integrity.
Evelyn Hall	Assists the superintendent regarding proper use, maintenance, and restoration of Evelyn Hall.
Friends of the Chautauqua Trail	Attend, participate, and share information at network conferences for the betterment of Bay View by expanding relationship with other Chautauqua organizations.
Historic Awareness	Protect and promote the history of the Association to members and guests.
Historical Commission/Museum	Collect, maintain, and display items which reflect Bay View's rich heritage.
Legislative	Develop and nurture positive working relationships with federal, state, and local government officials and community leaders.
Library	Oversee management of the Library and enhance its usage with innovative programming and adding new titles.
Marketing	Builds strategy and action recommendations to increase the public as well as member visibility to Bay View's values and offerings. This includes messaging and outreach via ads, articles, newsletters and social media.
Membership Engagement	Work with new and existing members to connect them with opportunities for involvement in Bay View programs and community life.
Memorial Gardens	Oversee all maintenance and planting of the garden.
Morning Council	Social club for women that seeks to enhance and sustain Bay View programming by focusing on the needs of Bay View children and fostering friendships in the community.
Music	Host social events to connect Music Festival students with Bay View and its members.
Plat	Make final decisions on preliminary and final plat requests and recommend those to the Board.
Technology	Develop a master plan for the use and implementation of technology, in addition to a document retention policy.
Theatre Arts	Provide volunteers to help on and off stage during major theatre productions.
Tree Advisory	Help to maintain healthy and diverse tree canopy by replacing dying trees to prevent eradication by disease.
Woman's Council	Manage the Woman's Council building and inspires service and sociability among the women of Bay View.
Woods Advisory	Advises on stewardship of the woods and trails.
