

## Proposed Current Issues Communication Policy

1. The bulletin boards at the post office will be not be used for current issues communication.
  - a) Posting any material that is obscene, vulgar, defamatory, threatening, discriminatory, harassing, abusive, or hateful to another person or entity will not be allowed.
  - b) Bay View members/associate members/guests will not remove public notices on bulletin boards.
  - c) Those that post an event on the post office bulletin boards shall remove the notice once the event has occurred.
2. A new Current Issues Opinion bulletin board will be erected in the vicinity of the post office.
  - a) Posting any material that is obscene, vulgar, defamatory, threatening, discriminatory, harassing, abusive, or hateful to another person or entity will not be allowed.
  - b) All opinion sheets placed on the Current Issues Opinion bulletin will include the opinion holder's name, block and lot.
    - i. Bay View members/associate members/guests will not remove opinion sheets from the Current Issues Opinion board unless they are the poster or have specific permission from the poster.
    - ii. If there is to be an event scheduled, e.g. a porch conversation, education class, or Friday Forum, regarding the opinion, a notice of the event may be placed on the post office bulletin board.
3. (1 year trial) Current Issues Communication will not be allowed on Bay View Association managed sidewalks (all sidewalks throughout the Bay View Association including the sidewalks on campus, on common grounds, and in front of cottages), except for a designated section of sidewalk leading up to and underneath the Bay View Bell Tower.
  - a) Current Issues Chalking of the designated section of sidewalk will be by weekly sign-up through the Bay View Business office for Bay View Members/Associate Members for no more than two weeks per issue during the 8 week Assembly season.
    - i. Members/Associate Members and their family members may do the chalking which is to include the name and any associated block/lot of the artist.
    - ii. The week of chalking will begin on Friday morning and be removed the following Thursday afternoon in preparation for the next week's display.
      1. If rain removes the chalking the member/associate member may re-chalk the display.
  - b) Chalking of Bay View Association campus will not be allowed for any purpose, other than in the predetermined Current Issues Chalking area.
  - c) Chalking of Bay View Association managed sidewalks in front of cottages and on common grounds will be allowed for traditional uses such as hopscotch, birthday greetings, children's art, and Hares and Hounds.
4. Saturday Current Issues Forum
  - a) Open forum for members to come together to share thoughts and ideas regarding a current issue.
  - b) Location/Time will depend on other Bay View Association programming.
5. Editorial Board
  - a) Chair and Board composition to be determined.
  - b) Responsible for selecting 3 or 4 community letters of 200 words or less for the Town Crier and/or behind the member wall.
